A Special Drive for admission in PG Programmes at School of Planning and Architecture, Bhopal, will be conducted to fill possible vacant seats in the categories of OPEN, SC, ST, EWS, OBC-NCL and PwD across various PG programmes.

1. Applications are invited for the following programmes:

- i. Master of Planning (Urban and Regional Planning)
- ii. Master of Planning (Environmental Planning)
- iii. Master of Planning (Transport Planning and Logistic Management)
- iv. Master of Architecture (Urban Design)
- v. Master of Architecture (Landscape) / Master of Landscape Design
- vi. Master of Architecture (Conservation) / Master of Conservation
- vii. Master of Design

2. A candidate can apply for a single programme only

3. A candidate is required to submit application form online at the given link:

a) A candidate shall be required to pay an application fee of INR 2,000/- (OPEN / EWS / OBC-NCL) and INR 1,000/- (SC / ST / PWD) through SBI I-Collect link <https://www.onlinesbi.sbi/sbicollect/icollecthome.htm> (Select State Madhya Pradesh, Educational Institutions, School of Planning & Architecture) by **28 July 2023**

b) Candidates who had earlier applied / appeared for the PG Direct Admission-2023 / Entrance examination conducted by SPA Bhopal for session 2023-24 and wish to apply for admission through special drive are required to apply again. But they are exempted from paying the application fee

4. Selection of candidates will be on the basis of written test and / or interview through online mode, dates of which will be communicated later

5. Valid SC / ST / EWS / PwD certificate as per Central Government format along with the required documents and credential are to be compulsorily submitted along with form

6. Award of GATE / CEED Scholarship shall be subject to the norms as decided by the Institute

Note:

The category wise Seat Matrix is subject to availability of vacant seats in the respective programmes at the time of special drive admission. If the Institute is unable to offer seat in any of the categories with respect to any of the disciplines mentioned above, the application fee remitted by applicants in that category and discipline will be refunded in full.
