5. The terms and conditions of appointment, including the remuneration payable to the IEMs, should not be included in the Integrity Pact or the NIT. This may be communicated individually to the IEMs concerned.
6. The revised Standard Operating Procedure (SOP) for adoption and implementation of Integrity Pact (IP) issued vide Circular No. 04/06/23 dated 14.06.2023 is available on Commission's website i.e. <https://cvc.gov.in>. The SOP may be made available to the IEMs for reference purpose. A copy of Commission's guidelines on "Illustrative check points for various stages of public procurement", available on Commission's website, under CTE's corner may also be provided to the IEMs at the time of their appointment, for guidance purpose.
7. It may be noted that as per Para 5.2 of revised SOP dated 14/06/23, it is necessary for the organization concerned to hold quarterly meetings with the IEMs, which may be complied with by the organization.
8. It may also be noted that as per revised SOP for implementation of Integrity Pact issued vide Circular No. 04.06.2023 dated 14.06.2023, two IEMs are to be nominated in organizations other than Maharatna and Navratna companies. Hence, Ministry of Education is advised to approach the Commission for nomination of 2nd IEM for SPA, Bhopal, after following due process.

Brief work experience

I have more than 36 years of experience in critical posts on Indian Railways where I have worked in departments related to train operations, commercial matters, vigilance and in General Administration. Some of the important postings have been as Divisional Commercial Manager, Sr. Divisional Operations Manager, Area Manager, Chief Passenger Traffic Manager, Executive Director/Traffic Transportation, Divisional Railway Manager, Principal Executive Director/Vigilance and Additional Member in the Railway Board. I was the Divisional Railway Manager (DRM) on the critical Moradabad Division of Northern Railway where I was responsible for every aspect of Railway operations including handling Passenger and Freight Traffic, Safety, Commercial operations, Finance, Engineering and Maintenance activities, Construction and Infrastructure Development Works, Procurements, tendering activities and in policy making. I have also worked extensively in posts involving matters related to Vigilance. I have been Executive Director Vigilance/Traffic/ Railway Board from August, 2013 to January, 2015 and then Principal Executive Director Vigilance and CVO of the Ministry of Railways for almost four years (January 2015 to November 2018), a post which involved close coordination with the Central Vigilance Commission. The work involved Vigilance Administration on Indian Railways where the CVO heads a department of around 1200 Vigilance Officials, including approximately 165 officers. The assignment included responsibilities towards examination of complaints, investigations into complaints and follow up action on the investigated cases. Railway Vigilance also conducts Preventive Checks to audit systems of working and has been instrumental in making suggestions for System Improvements regularly. Thus, I have substantive knowledge and experience of anti-corruption work which, inter-alia, included examination of tendering, contracting and procurement related matters. After my retirement from service, I was appointed as Member Technical (Apex Grade) in the Railway Claims Tribunal in the Principal Bench at Delhi where I served for 4 years from 12.06.2020 till 11.06.2024. This was a quasi-judicial appointment and involved adjudicating claims cases filed under The Railways Act. During my tenure of 4 years, I delivered judgements in approximately 1000 cases and the appointment gave me enormous exposure to legal aspects of a variety of issues handled by Government organisations. The combination of field experience, work in administrative and policy making positions, substantial knowledge and experience of Vigilance working as well as my exposure to legal aspects from working in the Railway Claims Tribunal perhaps equip me for working as an IEM.

This added to my earlier extensive experience of the Transportation and Logistic sectors, including activities related to Rail, Ports, Warehousing, Mines etc. My course in the National Defence College (2009) has equipped me with knowledge of the defence and strategic sectors. As I have worked in a training

institute (IRITM), I also have knowledge of running a training institute and training related requirements.

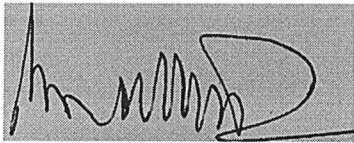
