Notes:

- i. Online classes and assignments are to be completed for all theory subjects by 19th April 2020 and the vacations can start in continuation to lockdown. For major studio subjects such as design/planning studios, seminar and BMC, the requirement of contact discussions and evaluation would be conducted once students report back on 13th June 2020. Hostel accommodation would be available from 13th June onwards.
- ii. Students and faculty would continue to be in touch throughout the vacation for guidance of Thesis. For studios, specific work deliverables are to be worked out and the same to be reviewed if felt necessary through online discussions before and during vacation. However contact hours would be compulsory on returning back from vacation for concluding the studio based subjects. Departments will inform each batch as to which subjects will be completed online and which will have a contact component on returning.
- iii. Students will need to make only one trip back by mid June by when situation may be much more stable across the country. After the end semester examinations, students will not be given any other semester end break. New semester would start after about a two week break when students would require to remain on campus depending on the situation in the country. Travel outside campus in this break may be restricted.
- iv. Students of B. Arch. VIII Semester currently undertaking training would have to report back to campus in June (date to be communicated by Training and Placement Cell) and have their viva voce during the End Semester Examinations. Detailed instructions will be communicated separately to this batch via e-mail.
- v. The Summer Training for the M. Arch students between 2nd and 3rd Semesters would be cancelled for this batch. They would be required to undertake a shorter training of 4 weeks in the winter break of Winter break of 2020 or after Thesis of 2021, and the format of these can be decided by Departments and may include other types than those mentioned.
- vi. The Professional Training which is part of the B. Plan VII Semester curriculum would be shifted to the end of the semester from mid October to December. Students of this batch would have their classes in August and September followed by End semester examinations in first week of October. They would then leave for Training and then return in the next semester in January 2021.
- vii. All Supplementary examinations for Odd and Even semesters would be conducted in one slot with the odd semesters supplementary examinations in the first week, from 20.7.2020, followed by the even semester supplementary in the next week after the evaluation of current semester examinations of even semester is completed.
- viii. New session registration would be on 3rd-5th August 2020 for current batches, with provisional admission, subject to results of supplementary examinations.
- ix. Date of admission of new UG and PG batches would depend on communications from JoSSA/CSAB and CCMT/SPAB admission committee respectively and would be communicated later.
- x. Attendance clauses of passing and detention would not be considered this semester, in view of the unusual circumstances.
