

## INSTRUCTIONS FOR DOCTORAL AND MASTER DEGREE PROGRAMMES

### **Application Fee for Master Degree Programmes -**

- Candidates are required to submit separate application form by online process which will start from 14.04.2016.
- Candidates are required to pay the application fee through State Bank Collect. Print out of e-filled form with copy of required documents (see other instructions) should be posted and must reach to SPA Bhopal by 16<sup>th</sup> May 2016 by speed post or registered Post for each programme applying.
- Application fee for each Master of Architecture/ each Master of Planning Degree Programmes ₹ 1500 (for Gen/OBC/) and ₹ 500 (SC/ST/PWD) for programme applying.
- Candidates applying for more than one degree programme are required to pay respective amount (i.e. ₹ 1500 for one programme, ₹ 3000 for two programmes, ₹ 4500 for three, ₹ 6000 for four and ₹ 7500 for applying in all five programmes. For SC/ST/PWD candidate, ₹ 500 for one programme, ₹ 1000 for two programmes, ₹ 1500 for three programmes, ₹ 2000 for four programmes and ₹ 2500 for applying in all five programmes.

### **Application Fee for Doctoral Programme -**

Application fee for Doctoral Programme is ₹1500 (for Gen/OBC) and ₹ 500 (for SC/ST/PWD).

### **Eligibility -**

**For Doctoral Programme** - Minimum educational qualifications for admission to Ph.D. programme of SPA Bhopal in Architecture and Planning shall be:

Master's Degree in Architecture/ Planning/ Technology/ Design disciplines or equivalent degree with minimum 60% marks OR B.Arch./ B.Plan. degree with minimum 60% marks, minimum five years of professional experience and at least one publication in Journal/ Conference proceedings.

The admission eligibility requirements of minimum marks may be relaxed to 55% marks to the following categories:

- SC/ ST applicants
- Any category of Persons with disabilities

**For Post Graduate Programme in Planning:** Minimum 55% marks in aggregate in B.Arch./ B.Plan./ B.E./B.Tech. in Civil Engineering/ M.Sc./ M.A. in Geography/ Economics/ Sociology.

**For Post Graduate Programme in Architecture:** B.Plan with minimum one year of experience or B.Arch. Both with minimum 55% marks in aggregate. However B.Plan. students will not be eligible for Council of Architecture registration as per present regulation.

**Reservation of Seats** - Reservation for all the courses will be applicable as per rules of Government of India.

**For admission through DASA Scheme in UG and PG programme for FN/PIO/NRI category, eligible candidate may visit web site of DASA 2016. However DASA students may not be eligible for Council of Architecture registration as per present regulation.**

### **Other instructions:**

- 1) The candidates should fill application form online.
- 2) Incomplete application in any respect is liable to be rejected.
- 3) Send the application form (print out e-filled form) with copy of required documents latest by 16.05.2016.
- 4) The following documents should be enclosed along with the application form (enclosed sets

of Xerox copy in each application form in which you are applying)

- Self attested copy of valid GATE score or UGC/NET fellowship.
- Self attested copy of Mark-sheets of 10<sup>th</sup>, 12<sup>th</sup> & qualifying Degree.
- In the case of candidates who have appeared or will be appearing in the qualifying examination, self attested copies of the latest mark sheets are to be submitted. Final mark sheets/Grade Sheets and provisional degree certificate are required to be submitted by 15<sup>th</sup> September 2016, (if admitted) failing which admission will be cancelled.
- Self attested copy of proof of date of birth.
- Self attested copy of certificate in the case of SC/ST candidates from a Competent Authority (Not below rank of a Tahsildar).
- Self attested copy of certificate in the case of OBC candidates from a Competent Authority (not below the rank of a Tahsildar).
- Self attested copy of experience certificate.
- **Research proposal (use separate sheets, 500 words approx. For Doctoral Program.)**
- **Statement of Purpose (use separate sheets, 200 words approx. For Masters Program, separately for each programme applying).**
- Sponsorship certificate duly filled by the Sponsoring Authority (with the seal of the Sponsoring Authority) in the prescribed format.
- Self attested copy of proof of all research publications in journal and conference.

### **PG Admission Test: Course Outline**

#### **M. Arch.**

##### **CONSERVATION**

The admission test intends to assess the aptitude of the candidate towards Architectural Conservation. The test shall include objective type questions towards general awareness of the candidate on heritage and conservation, and shall require the candidate either to sketch or to label various architectural elements and architectural style in the given sketch (es).

##### **LANDSCAPE**

The admission test intends to assess the aptitude of the candidate towards Landscape Architecture. The test shall include questions towards general awareness on Landscape

Architecture and candidates shall be required to write in brief about why they want to become landscape architects.

## **URBAN DESIGN**

The admission test intends to assess the aptitude of the candidate towards Urban Design. The test shall include questions on general awareness of the candidate on Urban Design/Urbanism and shall require the candidate to sketch streetscapes and interpret maps.

## **Master of Planning**

### **Environmental Planning**

The admission test intends to assess the aptitude of the candidate towards Environmental Planning. The test shall include questions towards general awareness of the candidate *current* environmental concerns, acquaintance with current national government programmes on urban and rural development, and basic understanding of quantitative tools and computer applications

The test shall include questions towards general awareness of the candidate *current* urban affairs, acquaintance with current national government programmes on urban and rural development, and basic understanding of quantitative tools and computer applications
